Step 4: Select Garden Type (More on Following Slide)

Warning! Some types of urban agriculture projects have specific fields. If you change the type of project, new information may be required and data that isn't required will be deleted.

Toronto Parks community gardens

These are gardens on City of Toronto Parks, Forestry and Recreation lands that are run by community groups or organizations. Allotment gardens are not included in this category.

Public Housing Community Gardens

These are gardens on lands owned by public housing providers that are generally for the use of tenants.

Other community gardens

Any garden run by a community group or organization that is not on Parks or Toronto Community Housing property. These can include gardens on private property, businesses or faith organizations.

Allotment gardens

These are gardens run by the City of Toronto where gardeners pay an annual rental fee. The garden is managed by City staff rather than a committee of gardeners.

School and children's gardens

Whether they are on school property or other space, the main purpose of these gardens is to engage children in gardening activities. This does not include community gardens which have some children's programming but it is not the main focus of the garden.

Producers

People, businesses or collectives who grow food or other products (seeds, flowers, medicines) for sale.

Other urban ag businesses

Businesses that provide urban agriculture related services, such as garden installation and consulting.

Organizations

Non-profit organizations, networks, associations and institutions that support urban agriculture or include it in their regular programming.

Rooftop gardens

This includes community gardens, institutional gardens and for-profit producers located on rooftops.

Greenhouses

Urban growing in a greenhouse, hoop house or areas in a building that are dedicated to plant propagation.

Beehives

Any beekeeping operation.

Orchards

Any space used for growing fruit and nut trees and shrubs.

Other




